

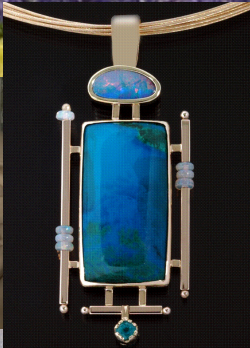

ABOUT the Festival

The Haywood County Arts Council will present International Festival Day on Saturday, July 31, 2010. Celebrating its 25th year, IFD brings artists, food vendors, and Folk-moot USA dancers and musicians to downtown Waynesville. The festival traditionally draws a crowd of 12,000 to 15,000 visitors.

The festival routinely hosts more than 95 artists representing the full range of arts including: jewelry, ceramic, wood, fiber, metal, two-dimensional art and more.

ARTIST POLICIES, PROCEDURES, REQUIREMENTS

Products

- The exhibiting artist must produce all work by hand. Only original handmade works are eligible for consideration, display, and sale. No imports by artists from other countries. NO COMMERCIAL ITEMS allowed in show. Only International Guests and Folkmoot groups are exempted from the rule regarding products made by artists living in another country.
- Photographs must include all work you plan to display and sell at IFD. Example: if you make pottery and jewelry, you must include photos of both your pottery and jewelry if both are to be displayed at the festival.
- All sales are limited to those described in your application and approved by the festival jury.
- All artists must provide their own **white** tent for display on the street. **Tents must be white to be considered for the festival.**

General

- All fees are due with application. The \$25 application fee is non-refundable. There is no rain date and no refund in case of rain. Leaving the festival or not appearing due to rain **will** jeopardize future festival acceptance.
- In the event that an artist is accepted into the festival but decides not to attend, no booth fees will be returned after July 2, 2010.
- There is to be no selling or solicitation outside booth (s) and no loud sound systems.
- Each artist is responsible for collecting and reporting appropriate sales tax to: **Sales & Use Tax Division, NC Department of Revenue, PO Box 25000, Raleigh, NC 27640.** Visit www.dor.state.nc.us for more information.
- The Haywood County Arts Council, Folkmoot USA and/or the Town of Waynesville are to be held blameless, and are not responsible for losses, damages, or personal liability.
- **The Arts Council reserves the right to remove any exhibitor violating festival policies, procedures or requirements.**

Artist Awards

Artist awards will be given in the following categories: **Best in Show (\$500); First Place (\$300); Second Place (\$200); and Third Place (\$100).**

Fees

All fees are due with the application. Booth fees will be refunded if artist is not selected to participate in show. We accept payment by credit card, money order, or personal check.

Application Fee (non-refundable)	\$25
One Booth (10x12)	\$150
Two Booths (12x20)	\$300

Applications must be postmarked by **Monday, May 3, 2010** to be considered for IFD 2010. Acceptance and notification letters will be sent no later than June 1, 2010.

Entry Instructions

Use the checklist below as all submissions must include the following to be considered for IFD 2010. Any application not including these items may be refused admission to the festival **regardless** of past involvement.

- \$25 non-refundable application fee, appropriate booth fees
- Application form - completed and signed
- Three (3) photographs representing all of your work that you plan to sell
- One (1) photograph of your booth display
- One (1) photograph of artist creating the work
- Price range of work

If paying fees by *Visa or MasterCard*, you may include credit card information on your application or call the office with credit card information. Applications will be processed only after application, booth fees and photos are received.

****NOTE:** *Photographs become the property of IFD and will not be returned. Show director reserves the right to assign returning artists new booth spaces regardless of assigned spaces in previous shows.*
