In making this request, you agree to accept the following conditions and requirements:

- I/We will work with QTWNC regarding design and colors of the proposed quilt square block.
- The block cannot be my company logo, nor can the installed block be used as my company logo. There must be at least 2' of blank space around the 4' and 8' blocks, and 1' around the smaller blocks, when installed.
- The Quilt Block must remain on the building at least five years.
- Once the block is signed off on, no changes may be made to the block and I will not move or alter the quilt block in any way. I understand that if I move to a new location the quilt block remains with the site where it is originally installed. A new location requires a new block. I cannot take the quilt block with me UNLESS it is painted to match a family quilt or is a custom-designed block.
- I will allow my barn/building to be photographed by the public and photos to be used by QTWNC/HCAC in advertising the quilt trails. I will allow my name and/or my business name to be used on advertising and promotional materials.
- I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Quilt Trails of Western North Carolina and the Haywood County Arts Council as well as its officers, committees, agents and employees for and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses and causes of action related to the quilt block.

Design theme (check one)

- I am providing a design (photo attached).** If you wish, please share what the design means to you. For example, the design might come from your family's heirloom quilt, or relate to your personal interests or family history.

- I would like help choosing an existing design.** Don't know the design you want? No problem! We can help you find the right block to tell your story. A terrific source is *The Encyclopedia of Pieced Quilt Patterns* by Barbara Brackman, available in most county libraries. To figure your price, use the "up to 50 sections" amount.
- I would like to have a block custom designed.** If you would like to commission a design, please *complete the Custom Design Questionnaire* on the following page to help the designer create a block that best reflects your chosen theme and style. For a custom-designed block, add \$150 plus applicable tax. This is a nonrefundable fee.

What is a Section? Every part of the block that is separate from other areas is referred to as a section. More complex designs, designs with curves, or designs that are painted to match the fabric in a family quilt take longer to tape and cost more. Blocks with curves cannot be taped but must be painted freehand.


